Edward Bonhotal Morello, 77, of Ogden, Iowa and formerly of Iowa City, died at the Ogden Manor on Monday evening, April 22, 2013. Edward was born May 23, 1935 in Boone, Iowa, the son of Lester and Ruth (Hunter) Morello. Edward worked for Quinn Iron Works in Boone for a number of years in the 1960's before moving to Iowa City in 1968 to work for United Technologies (formerly Sheller-Globe) where he became the Director of Engineering for many years and retired in June 1997. After more than 10 years of retirement near Iowa City, in 2003 he moved to Ogden, Iowa. Edward was an avid fisherman on the rivers and lakes of Iowa and Canada.
