Evalyn Ewing, 82, formerly of 733 6th Street in Boone, passed away at the Eastern Star Masonic Home in Boone on Friday morning, May 16, 2008. She had been a resident at the Home since September of 2005. She was born on March 1, 1926 in Boone, Iowa the daughter of Edward and Rubye (Marshal) Ewing. On April 26, 1946, she married E.
