Roydan Soder, 46, of 3453 Yankee Avenue in Stratford, Iowa passed away at the Boone county Hospital in Boone, Iowa on Thursday morning, March 6, 2006. He was born on August 12, 1961 in Redfield, South Dakota the son of Wayne and Judy (Tuel) Soder. In 1988, he married Rosa Linda Brobst at Albuquerque, New Mexico. Roydan graduated from Stratford High School in 1979 and Platt College of Drafting and Design in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma with a major in Electro-Mechanical Drafting and Design in 1987.
